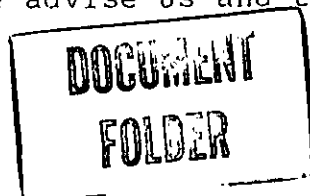
Dear Mr. Zeigler:

On January 6, 1993 we mailed to the Commission, with a U.S. Postal Service Certificate of Mailing Form 3817, the signed original and two copies of the Verified Statements of the applicant and three supporting shippers in connection with the above application.

On January 14, 1993 we received the signed original of the verified statement of Carl F. Ogborne, Jr. on behalf of Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. in support of the application. The Verification was signed by Mr. Ogborne on December 20, 1992 but it was not mailed to us until several days ago.



VERIFIED STATEMENT OF CARL F. OGBORNE, JR.  
ON BEHALF OF OGBORNE WASTE REMOVAL, INC.

1. Legal Name and Domicile of Supporting Shipper.

The supporting shipper is Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. and its business address is 10 Reaney Street, Chester, Delaware County, Pennsylvania 19013.

2. Identity and Qualifications of Testifying Witness.

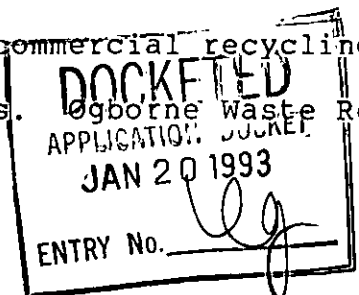
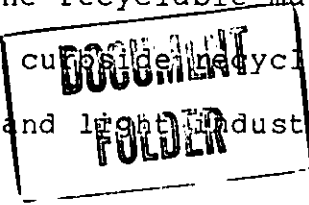
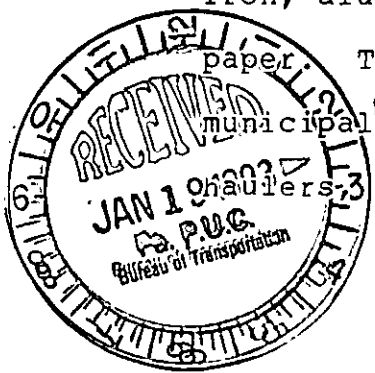
My name is Carl F. Ogborne, Jr. and I am the President of Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. I have been the President of Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. for 16 years. My business address is the same as that of the company.

As President, I am responsible for overseeing all of the operations of the company. This includes supervising and reviewing the arrangements for the transportation and sales of recyclable materials. I am familiar with the transportation needs of my company and I am submitting this statement in support of the application of Marianne Industries, Inc. at Docket No. A-00109648, F. 2, Am-A.

3. General Description of Supporting Shipper.

Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. is engaged in the waste removal and recycling business. The company's operations include receiving recyclable materials such as glass, plastic, wood, iron, aluminum, newspaper, cardboard, bimetal cans and mixed

paper. The recyclable materials are delivered to the company by municipal curbside recycling programs, commercial recycling haulers and light industrial facilities.



then arranges for the sale and transportation of the recyclable materials to glass plants, iron yards, paper recyclers, plastic recyclers, aluminum recyclers, wood processors, etc.

Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc.'s facility is located in Chester, Delaware County. It consists of a collection site and processing center for the recyclable materials. The facility ships and receives materials between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., five and one half days per week.

4. Volume and Frequency of Intended Use and Representative Origins and Destinations.

All outbound shipments of recyclable glass originate at the company's facility in Chester. The company ships its flint glass (white glass) through interstate commerce to a facility located in New Jersey. All of the brown and green recyclable glass is currently shipped to Monack Glass Recycling located in Belle Vernon, Fayette County. As the volume of recyclable glass continues to increase, the company anticipates that it will need to contract with additional glass processors to purchase the glass collected by the company.

All of the glass is shipped in truckload quantities in dump trailers. Each truckload weighs approximately 22 tons. On the average, the company ships one truckload of brown or green glass to Belle Vernon each week. This amounts to approximately 50 shipments and 1,100 tons annually.

5. Type of Service Required.

Ogborne Waste Removal requires that its motor carrier be

able to make pick-ups and deliveries according to schedule. On certain days of the week, there are numerous deliveries made to the company's facility, and to avoid congestion, pick-ups must occur on other days. Deliveries must be made according to the schedule set by the company receiving the materials.

Due to the nature of the commodities being shipped, the company requires tractors with dump trailers. The carrier must also have tarps to cover the glass during transit. The carrier must have sufficient equipment to transport the size of the loads and the volume of traffic being shipped.

#### 6. Similar Applications Supported.

In the past two years, Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. has not supported any similar applications.

#### 7. Other Pertinent Information.

Ogborne Waste Removal, Inc. has utilized the Applicant's services for interstate shipments for approximately 18 months. The Applicant's service has been excellent.

Approval of this application will improve the company's ability to compete with shippers of similar products by making sufficient motor vehicle equipment available to the company. The company anticipates a need to transport an increased volume of recyclable glass as additional communities implement recycling programs. Thus, approval of this application will serve the company's present need for additional equipment and will also serve to increase available carriers to meet Ogborne Waste Removal's increasing needs for motor carrier service.

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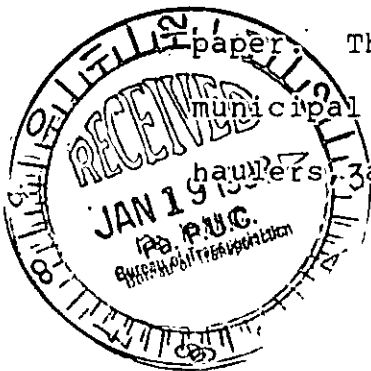

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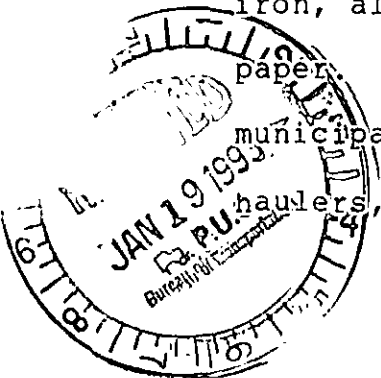
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
