Dear Respondent:

On April 16, 1999, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against Marianne Industries, Inc., respondent, alleging failure to maintain proper evidence of current insurance in violation of the Public Utility Code. The respondent was duly notified that if acceptable evidence of insurance or an answer was not filed, the Bureau would request that the Secretary of the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00109648, F. 2.
