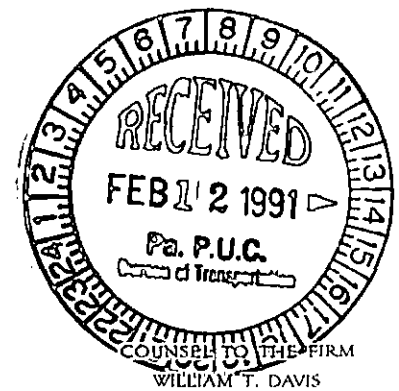

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

Attached hereto is a copy of the Transfer Agreement entered into between the parties.

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 25 day of January, 1991, by and between DENNIS B. LAUDER, t/d/b/a LITTLE CHIEF LUMBER, a proprietorship, of S.R., Box 54, Frenchville, PA 16836, referred to hereinafter as "Transferee", Party of the First Part,

LAUDER TRUCKING, INC., a Pennsylvania corporation, of R. D., Box 56, Woodland, PA 16881, referred to hereinafter as "Transferor", Party of the Second Part.

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, Transferor is the holder of certain motor carrier operating authority as previously issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in Docket No. A-108119. Attached hereto as Appendix A is a copy of that portion of the operating authority issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission which is the subject of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, Transferee is an individual, trading and doing business as a proprietorship, which desires to purchase a portion of the said operating authority of Transferor; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual covenants set forth herein, and with the intention of being legally bound, the

parties hereunto agree as follows:

(1) The total purchase price of the operating authority herein shall be One (\$1.00) Dollar. In view of the close working relationship between Transferor and Transferee, and the fact that Transferee is the son of Denzel H. Lauder, the owner of Lauder Trucking, Inc., the subject transfer essentially amounts to a family gift.

(2) This Agreement shall be effective upon the signing of the within document.

(3) A transfer application will be filed as soon as reasonably possible with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

(4) Approval of the transfer, by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, shall be deemed to occur and consummation shall be accomplished at the time an Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission is issued, served and received by counsel for Transferee, indicating that full and complete approval of the transfer rights has been accomplished.

(5) In the event that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission should refuse to transfer the authority as set forth in Appendix A, at the election of the Transferee, this Agreement may be declared null and void.

(6) Transferor hereby warrants and covenants that it is authorized to enter into this Agreement and that it holds the full operating authority in the document attached hereto as Appendix A.

(7) Transferor further warrants that it will comply with all

pertinent rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission during the pendency of a transfer proceeding that is filed relative to this matter.

(8) Transferor and Transferee hereby agree to take all reasonable steps necessary to properly obtain approval of the transfer of the said operating authority, such approval to be obtained from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

(9) Transferor and Transferee hereby specifically authorize Dwight L. Koerber, Jr., Esquire, and Kriner, Koerber and Kirk, of 110 North Second Street, P. O. Box 1320, Clearfield, PA 16830, to sign all documents relative to the filing and implementation of an adoption tariff, and/or any other tariff document, as might be required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission relative to this matter.

(10) Transferee agrees that he will pay the legal expenses associated with transferring the within operating authority, with Transferee also paying the filing fee required in the PUC transfer proceeding.

(11) The parties hereby agree to expeditiously execute all appropriate documents, which, in the opinion of Dwight L. Koerber, Jr., Esquire, are proper and necessary in order to obtain final approval of the transfer of the said operating authority from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

(12) It is agreed and understood that this Agreement shall be construed in accordance and under the laws of the Commonwealth of

Pennsylvania.

(13) The heirs, administrators, executors and assigns of the parties shall be bound by all terms, conditions and clauses of this Agreement, as if they had been mentioned in every provision hereof.

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed May 6, 1988. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of May 21, 1988. The unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing.

By the instant application for transfer of authority, Denzel H. Lauder, the transferor, seeks to transfer his operating authority into a corporation formed March 21, 1988. The principal place of business for the corporation is Box 56, Woodland, Clearfield County. Denzel H. Lauder is president and stockholder in the corporation.

The authority is being transferred for the nominal consideration of \$1.00. Motor vehicles, equipment and real estate are being transferred from the proprietorship to the corporation without consideration. There are no unpaid business debts of the transferor.

A review of the record before us indicates that the applicant possesses the requisite experience, equipment and financial capacity to provide the proposed service.

The authority to be transferred has been operated by the transferor, therefore, it is presumed that there is a continuing public need, which may be overcome only by evidence to the contrary. In re: Byerly, 440 Pa. 521 (1970); Hostatter v. Pa. P.U.C., 160 Super. Ct. 94 (1947). Since the record is void of any such evidence, this presumption of continuing public need applies in this transfer proceeding.

We find:

1. The applicant is fit, willing and able to provide the service proposed.
2. Transfer of the authority is in the public interest and is necessary for the continued accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the transfer application be and is hereby approved and that a certificate be issued granting the following rights:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, petroleum and petroleum products for Walcoal, Inc., from the Pennsylvania facilities of the said shipper, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

To transport, as a Class D carrier, unfinished wood products, from points in the counties of Cambria, Blair, Clearfield and Huntingdon, to points in Pennsylvania;

the right immediately above subject to the following condition:



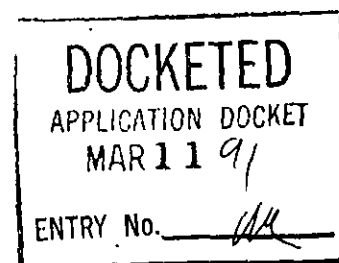
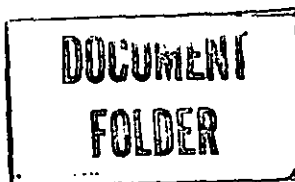
