
The reason I am writing this letter is due to the notice of penalty I received in the mail on Tuesday February 16<sup>th</sup> 2016. It was regarding the insurance not being filed with the P.U.C.

To Begin, when I first got my insurance with OOIDA I assumed that they filed the forms in with the state that day...They filed it but they must have forgot to file the ones for the P.U.C. When I received the first notice from you back on January 26<sup>th</sup> I immediately called OOIDA (Insurance provider) to check and see why they did not file it and they told me that they will do it as soon as possible that day...They called me back later on that day stating that it has been filed on the 26<sup>th</sup>. When I received the second Notice which is the one with the penalty I immediately called my insurance provider to see what's going on and they stated that everything has been filed on the 26<sup>th</sup> so then I called back the state and left a message so I called back on the 17<sup>th</sup> of February and spoke with Tatjana from the P.U.C. she said that OOIDA did not file on the 26<sup>th</sup>. Tatjana called me back once again around noon on the 17<sup>th</sup> and she advised me that she just then received the filings and she said the filings were dated back in on the 26<sup>th</sup> of January. She advised me to go to page three of the notice and write a letter to you to ask if I can have my penalty removed.

To conclude, we have been insured the whole time and I was not aware of the insurance not filing the information to P.U.C. when we accepted the insurance policy. Also, the insurance claimed that they have filed the paperwork on the 26<sup>th</sup> electronically and they stated the filing went through. When I called them back when I received the penalty letter they immediately refilled it and Tatjana confirmed that P.U.C. received it. I would like to ask if the penalty can be removed and I will make sure this does not happen again. We are a very small company and having a \$500 dollar fine will jeopardize our business.

Thank you for taking the time to read this and thank you for your consideration in removing the penalty.

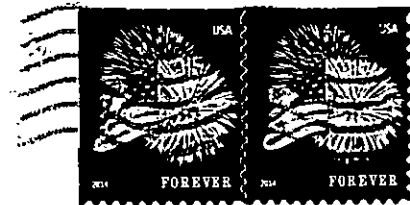
