Applicant has been granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, initially consisting of outbound "1+" interLATA and intraLATA toll and toll-free services, dedicated private line, data, operator assisted calling exclusively to subscribers of records and directory assistance (Utility Code 3118196).

Applicant now proposes to provide competitive local exchange services to commercial subscribers. Specifically Applicant proposes to provide local exchange services including dial tone, custom calling features and dedicated intraexchange private line services. Applicant also proposes to offer switched exchange access services to interconnecting carriers. Applicant will utilize a combination of leased network elements including local switching, end office shared trunk ports and tandem transport and switching to provide local exchange and switched exchange access services. Retail local exchange services will be supplemented by resale of other local exchange carrier services.

Initially, Applicant will provide local exchange services in the same service territories currently served by CornerStone Telephone Company, LLC following Commission approval of an asset acquisition transaction (See Joint Application for Approval of a General Rule Transaction, filed contemporaneously with the instant Application).

11. **SERVICE AREA:** Describe the geographic service area in which the Applicant proposes to offer services. 
