Re: Participants in PMTA's Household Goods Carrier's Tariffs

To whom it may concern:

By letter dated July 28, 1999, Elizabeth J. Fischer, Director, Meeting Services/Tariffs, Pennsylvania Motor Truck Association (PMTA), advised all Public Utility Commission (Commission) certificated household goods carriers participating in PMTA's household goods freight tariffs, that PMTA would be canceling all of PMTA's tariffs effective October 28, 1999.

As of the date of this correspondence, the Commission has not received a new tariff on your behalf, containing rates which would replace the PMTA rates, nor has the Commission received evidence of your participation in the tariffs of another tariff agency which currently has rates on file with this Commission for the transportation of household goods, in use.

It will be necessary that the Commission receive, no later than fifteen (15) days from the date of this correspondence, a tariff which contains rates which are equal to the PMTA rates which were on file with this Commission, or a tariff indicating your participation in the tariffs of a tariff agency which has rates on file with this Commission for the transportation of household goods, in use. Should you decide to file a tariff containing individual rates, rather than participate in a tariff agency's rates, and the proposed rates are higher than those of PMTA, the newly filed rates will be considered a rate increase, and will require financial justification demonstrating that the proposed rates are reasonable and just.

If your household goods authority is not being exercised, and you wish removal of the right(s) which authorizes the transportation of household goods, in use, please contact the Compliance Office, Applications Unit, at (717) 783-5946, for information on how to eliminate the right(s). Should there be any questions regarding the filing of a new tariff, please contact Monroe Dove at (717) 787-5945.

We represent Phillips Crane & Equipment Rentals, Inc., which holds both property authority and household goods authority from the Commission at lead Docket No. A-94626. Our client was a participant in the Pennsylvania Motor Truck Association's Household Goods Carrier Tariffs. We understand that PMTA's tariffs were cancelled as of October 28, 1999.

Our client has decided to sell its household goods rights, and we are in the process of notifying interested parties and soliciting offers for these rights. Our client has not conducted any household goods operations since October 28, 1999, and it does not intend to conduct any household goods operations while it is attempting to sell the household goods rights.

Accordingly, we hereby request on behalf of our client a voluntary suspension of only the household goods portion of the operating rights issued to Phillips Crane & Equipment Rentals, Inc. at Docket No. A-00111159 pending the sale. We understand that this voluntary suspension will be made effective October 28, 1999, and that it will remain in effect for a period of one year until on or about October 28, 2000.

It is our understanding that the motor carrier of property rights held by our client at Docket No. A-00111159 will remain in effect and that those rights will not be subject to the voluntary suspension. If you have any questions concerning this matter, please contact the undersigned.

Dear Mr. O'Boyle:

This will acknowledge receipt of your correspondence of December 9, 1999, which requests that that portion of the rights issued to Phillips Crane & Equipment Rentals, Inc. (respondent) at A-00111150, **which authorizes the transportation of household goods, in use**, be suspended.

After review of the record, it has been determined that a grant of a voluntary suspension for one (1) year is appropriate. The voluntary suspension is effective from October 28, 1999, the date the household goods tariffs of Pennsylvania Motor Truck Association's were canceled. The voluntary suspension will terminate on October 28, 2000. No transportation of household goods, in use, shall be rendered during the suspension.

If an application for the transfer of the authority at A-00094626, which authorizes the transportation of household goods, in use, is not filed by October 28, 2000, a complaint will be instituted against the respondent for failing to maintain just and reasonable rates on file with the Commission.

Please be advised that this grant of a voluntary suspension does not eliminate the need to pay any fines or fees due the Commission.
