Veteran Transportation Management LLC (Respondent) has paid the amount of the civil penalty agreed upon by the parties in order to resolve the above-docketed *complaint without litigation*. On March 3, 2016, the Commission received payment by check in the amount of \$250, which was the monetary fine agreed upon between the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) and Respondent to resolve the allegation that Respondent failed to maintain evidence of a bond or other financial security approved by the Commission. In addition, on February 29, 2016, the Commission received the continuation certificate related to Respondent's bond.
