PREHEARING ORDER

If objections are raised, I will be available during normal working hours, and on reasonable notice, to confer by telephone conference call to resolve any differences.

Counsel for Applicant shall provide counsel for Protestants copies of all exhibits to be presented on behalf of Applicant's direct case on or before March 12,


