In the event objections are raised, I will be available during normal working hours and on reasonable notice to confer by telephone conference call to resolve any differences that may arise.

Counsel for Applicant is directed to provide counsel for Protestants copies of all exhibits to be presented on behalf of Applicant's direct case on or before November 25, 1997. Counsel for Protestants are directed to provide copies of their exhibits

for their direct case prior to the start of the hearing on December 2, 1997.

Finally, all parties are reminded that each party wishing to offer an exhibit is required to provide two copies to the court reporter, one to the presiding officer and one to each party of record.
