TO PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Commerce Energy, Inc. (“Commerce Energy”) by and through its counsel, Karen O. Moury and Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney PC, hereby files this Certificate of Satisfaction in the above-captioned action, pursuant to Section 5.24 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.24. In support thereof, Commerce Energy states as follows:

1. On December 8, 2015, Ms. Christine (Polegato) Wright (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint against PECO Energy Company (“PECO”) and Commerce Energy.
2. On December 10, 2015, the Commission served the Formal Complaint on PECO and Commerce Energy.
3. Due to the Formal Complaint being mailed to the incorrect address, Commerce Energy did not become aware of its filing until it was electronically served with the Hearing Notice on January 14, 2016.¹
4. Commerce Energy filed an Answer *nunc pro tunc* on January 22, 2016.

¹ The Formal Complaint was eventually returned to the Commission on February 10, 2016 and the Formal Complaint was re-served on February 12, 2016.

5. Commerce Energy certifies that it entered into settlement discussions with the Complainant and has successfully achieved a mutually satisfactory resolution of the case. Based on that settlement, the Complainant has agreed not to pursue the Complaint against Commerce Energy.


6. The Complainant has authorized Commerce Energy to file this Certificate of Satisfaction.
