Jessee Irvin Murphy (Respondent) has paid the amount of the civil penalty agreed upon by the parties in order to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation. On February 10, 2016 and March 7, 2016, the Commission received payment by check in the amount of \$325, respectively. The total amount submitted, \$650, constitutes the monetary fine agreed upon between the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) and Respondent to resolve the allegation that Respondent held himself out to provide passenger service for compensation between points in Pennsylvania while not having operating authority with the Commission.
