On December 17, 2015, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) approved the Application of **ENGIE Retail, LLC d/b/a Think Energy (“Think Energy”)**, fka GDF SUEZ Retail Energy Solutions, LLC d/b/a Think Energy, and issued an Order and License at Docket No. A-2015-2510472 authorizing Think Energy to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply natural gas services as a Supplier to customers in the natural gas distribution company service territories of National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Peoples Natural Gas Company, LLC, Peoples Natural Gas Company, LLC – Equitable Division, Peoples TWP LLC, and Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc., within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

By this Application, Think Energy requests that the Commission amend Think Energy’s natural gas supplier license to include the additional service territory of **PECO Energy Company – Gas Division (“PECO”)**.
