Dear Sirs:

First, I am an low assets 84 year old on a very meager and fixed income and cannot tolerate cost increases of any kind. But, in addition to my human condition, I am writing to ask you not to approve the subject DSIC request for the following reasons.

Act 11 is designed to accelerate repair and replacement of existing and aging Distribution facilities, which would reduce the number and frequency of rate increase requests and also assure customer safety.

Current rates reflect costs associated with normal system maintenance and replacement. Unless Penn Power can prove there is eminent danger to their customers without any acceleration, then I believe the PPIC should disapprove.

If Penn Power can demonstrate there is danger then their management is derelict for not doing repairs and replacement on a timely basis - again reason for denial.

I also understand that Penn Power is seeking your approval before they determine the actual DSIC charge. Sounds like signing a blank check to me. Also, they can increase the DSIC charge quarterly. This is absolutely too open ended.

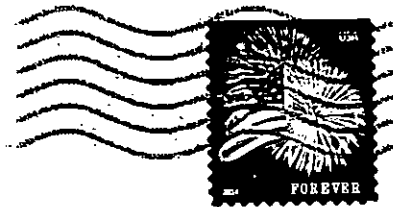
