To Whom it May Concern:

Recent Federal legislation entitled the Federal Aviation Authorization Act of 1994 provides that states will not be permitted to regulate rates, routes or service of motor carriers of property (except household goods in use) after January 1, 1995. The Federal legislation does not preempt state regulation of safety and insurance matters.

Due to the time constraints involved with publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin and filing of verified statements, your application was pending at the time the new legislation became effective; therefore, You are advised that:

1. You are granted authority to operate as follows:

To transport property, except household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

2. A certificate will be issued after you submit the following:

- a. Form E evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance.
- b. Form H evidence of cargo liability insurance.

3. If you fail to comply with the requirements contained in paragraph No. 2 above, within 60 days of the date of this letter, this application will be dismissed.

4. You must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review to be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date of this letter is entered. In lieu of a Safety Fitness Review, you may submit a copy of current satisfactory safety rating from the U. S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania.
