ORIGINAL

On December 31, 2003, BTS filed the above-captioned complaint, alleging that Metro abandoned service in violation of 52 Pa. Code §3.381(a)(5). By Order entered May 4, 2004, the Commission sustained the Complaint, cancelled Metro's certificate, and imposed a \$100 civil penalty as a result of Metro's failure to file an answer to the Complaint.

By Order entered July 27, 2004, the Commission rescinded the cancellation order since it learned that Metro filed an Answer prior to cancellation of its certificate. The July 27, 2004 Order also stated that the Answer had been referred to the Law Bureau for a decision on July 8, 2004. On August 12, 2004, the BTS closed the Complaint case because Metro paid the \$100 civil penalty.

Based upon the Law Bureau's review of the facts reflecting that Metro has filed its Assessment Reports and paid its civil penalty, thus satisfying the complaint at A-00113363C0302, the record in this case should remain closed.
