INTERIM ORDER SETTING SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

On or about March 29, 1999, Eric F. Wright Enterprises, Inc., t/d/b/a Eric's Moving ("Applicant") filed an application at the above-captioned Docket Number. On or about May 6, 1999, William H.R. Casey, Esquire filed a protest on behalf of eleven (11) Protestants ("Protestants").

Based upon a review of the pleadings, the parties are hereby directed to attempt to settle this matter. Applicant shall contact Protestants, on or before June 21, 1999, concerning a time, date and place for Protestants and Applicant to hold a conference. The conference shall take place on before July 6, 1999.

Within (10)days following the conference. Applicant shall file a short report with Herbert R. Nurick. ADR/Mediation Coordinator ("Coordinator"), setting forth:

- (a) date and place of the The time, settlement conference;
 - (b) Who participated for each party;
- A statement whether a full settlement (restricti amendment), including withdrawal of protests, was achieved, and,

if not, whether the parties consent to have this case set for mediation by the mediation staff of the Commission; and

(d) A statement of any issues which have been resolved, if a full settlement was not achieved.

If an agreement has not been reached, and the parties do not consent to mediate, the parties are entitled to have a hearing. A hearing is a formal procedure in which an administrative law judge will make a decision to resolve the case. Mediation is an informal procedure in which the parties themselves attempt to resolve the case through a voluntary agreement. The mediator is a neutral person who helps the parties in their efforts to come to an agreement. The Commission encourages mediation, where appropriate.
