PREHEARING ORDER

In order to expedite the conduct of the hearing, on or before April 15, 1997, counsel for the Applicant and the Protestants are directed to confer in person or by telephone to exchange the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all witnesses they intend to call during the hearing. In the course of conferring, they shall informally request copies of any documents deemed relevant so that any such document(s) may be reviewed prior to rather than during the hearing. In the event objections are raised, I will be available during normal working hours and on reasonable notice to confer by telephone conference call to resolve any differences that may arise.

Counsel for the Applicant is directed to provide counsel for the Protestants with copies of all exhibits to be presented on behalf of Applicant's direct case on or before April 21, 1997. Counsel for the Protestant is directed to provide copies of the exhibits for the Protestant's direct case prior to the start of the hearing on April 29, 1997.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b), requests for postponement or continuance of hearings must be submitted in writing no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing. Requests for postponement or continuance of initial hearings are to be sent to the Acting Chief Administrative Law Judge Robert A. Christianson with copies to the presiding officer and parties of record.

Finally, all parties are reminded that each party wishing to offer an exhibit is required to provide two copies to the court reporter, one copy to the presiding officer and one copy to each of party of record. 52 Pa. Code §5.409.

The parties shall comply with the procedural rules and regulations discussed herein.
