

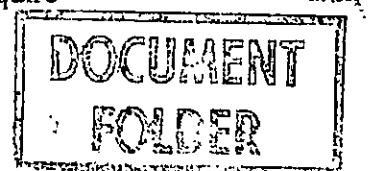


1. The Application prayed for is not necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience or safety of the public.

- (3) To transport, as a Class D carrier, property for the Fidelity-Twentieth Century Storage and Warehouse Company from its warehouse in the city of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, to points within an airline distance of two (200) statute miles of the Philadelphia City Hall, and vice versa; excluding the transportation of commodities in bulk, in tank vehicles.

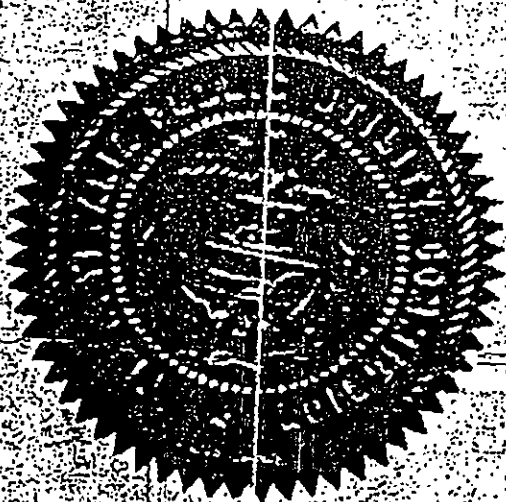

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application for emergency temporary authority filed on November 4, 1992. Applications for temporary and permanent authority were also filed at the same time.

Fischer-Hughes of Allentown, Inc., seeks a grant of emergency temporary authority which would permit it to assume the authority now held by Bair & Blaine Enterprises, Inc., t/d/b/a Diehl Storage Co. at A-00108845. Fischer-Hughes of Allentown, Inc. is domiciled at Allentown, Lehigh County. Applicant will provide service using two straight trucks, seven tractors and two trailers. Applicant has other equipment available in the case it is needed to serve the customers of Diehl Storage Co. Applicant will lease a warehouse in Allentown, Lehigh County, providing an office and terminal facilities for the operation of the rights. This facility will include offices, warehouse and storage space as well as a parking area for vehicles.

Applicant will have trained drivers, dispatchers and other personnel available during normal business hours. Communications with customers and drivers is by direct telephone line.

The transferor filed for protection under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code with the Eastern District of Pennsylvania Federal Court, No. 92-21606. By order dated September 17, 1992, the transferor was ordered to negotiate with the applicant for sale of its assets to the applicant.

including the Pennsylvania intrastate rights which are assigned a value of \$25,000. A condition of the Bankruptcy Court's Order requires the applicant to obtain emergency temporary authority from this Commission to operate the transferor's authority. A default in this matter could force the creditor to take possession of the transferor's assets and make it impossible for it to continue serving the public. A grant of emergency temporary authority to applicant would ensure continuing service to the public.

To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods, personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling, in connection with a removal by a householder from one house or dwelling to another; furniture, fixtures, equipment and the property of stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, when a part of the stock, equipment, or supply of such stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, in connection with a removal from one location to another; and articles, including objects of art, displays and exhibits, which because of their unusual nature or value, require specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods, between points in the city of Allentown, Lehigh County, and within forty (40) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of the said city of Allentown, excluding the city of Reading, Berks County, and the borough of Norristown, Montgomery County, and from points in the said city of Allentown and within forty (40) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits thereof, excluding the city of Reading and the borough of Norristown, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.


