

I. STATEMENT OF THE CASE

By application published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on November 2, 1996, Three Rivers Limousine Service, Inc. (Three Rivers Limousine or applicant) seeks authority to operate as a common carrier, transporting:

Persons in paratransit service from points in Allegheny County to other points in Pennsylvania and return; subject to the following condition: that no right, power or privilege is granted to provide service from points in the cities of McKeesport, Duquesne, and Clairton, and the boroughs of Glassport, Liberty, White Oak, Dravosburg, Port Vue, Versailles, Lincoln, Elizabeth, West Elizabeth, Trafford, Braddock, North Braddock, Jefferson and West Mifflin, and the townships of Elizabeth and North Versailles.

A single protest was filed to this application by The Yellow Cab Company of Pittsburgh, which has been withdrawn.

Applicant now submits its verified statements in support of the application.

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II. VERIFIED STATEMENT OF THE APPLICANT

1. Legal Name and Domicile of Carrier.

Applicant is Three Rivers Limousine Service, Inc. (Three Rivers Limousine). Three Rivers Limousine is a Pennsylvania corporation incorporated on November 5, 1980 and its business address is 1830 Painters Run Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15241.

2. Identity and Qualifications of Testifying Witness.

My name is Nicholas Romah and I am the President of Three Rivers Limousine. I am authorized to present this statement in support of the application of Three Rivers Limousine filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

3. Affiliation With Other Carriers.

Three Rivers Limousine is not affiliated with any other motor carriers.

4. Authority Sought.

The authority sought is set forth in the Statement of the Case, which precedes my statement.

5. General Description of Present Regulated Operations.

Three Rivers Limousine does not presently hold any operating authority from the Commission. Three Rivers Limousine does provide service within Allegheny County which is not regulated by the Commission.

6. Duplicating Authority Resulting From Grant of Application.

There will not be any duplicating authority resulting from a grant of this application.

7. Pertinent Terminal Facilities and Communications Network.

The office of Three Rivers Limousine is located at 1830 Painters Run Road, Pittsburgh;

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ENTRY No. [Signature]

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PA 15241. Three Rivers Limousine does not perform any maintenance at this facility but rather contracts out maintenance.

Three Rivers Limousine will operate under a central dispatch procedure under which drivers and equipment will be controlled from its office as set forth above.

8. Description of Equipment.

A list of the equipment operated by Three Rivers Limousine is attached to my statement as Appendix 1.

9. Safety Program and Compliance With DOT Safety Requirements.

Three Rivers Limousine maintains a safety program which includes safety meetings and administering the compliance by its employees with applicable safety regulations of the Department of Transportation. Three Rivers Limousine stresses the importance of safety of operations to its employees.

10. Service Now Provided to Supporting Parties.

Three Rivers Limousine does not presently provide service to the parties supporting this application.

11. Description of Services Proposed.

Three Rivers Limousine will offer to the public generally a shared ride service, although there could be occasions when only one person will be transported. We will require advanced reservations. Senior citizens and persons with impairments that limit their ability to drive will be encouraged to use this service. The service will be provided to persons who need to go to such activities as shopping, meetings, appointments etc.

12. Financial Data.

There is attached hereto as Appendix 2 the latest available balance sheet and income statement for Three Rivers Limousine, which is financially capable of providing the service sought by this application. The 1996 year end financial statements for Three Rivers Limousine are not yet available.

13. Additional Pertinent Evidence.

Three Rivers Limousine will comply with all of the Commission requirements involving insurance, tariffs etc. once this application is granted.

For all of the above reasons, Three Rivers Limousine respectfully requests that the Commission grant this application.
