You may operate pending receipt of permanent proof of insurance (Temporary proof of insurance is only good for 60 days).

If you have not previously submitted a copy of current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date this letter is entered. You will receive a separate letter on this subject.
