Royal Transportation LLC (Respondent) has paid, in full, its outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 Fiscal Year (2014-2015 Fiscal Year) and the requested civil penalty in order to resolve the above-docketed Complaint without litigation. The Commission received a check in the amount of \$500 on February 1 and March 1, 2016, respectively. On April 1, 2016, the Commission received a check in the amount of \$330. The total amount received, \$1,330, constitutes payment of Respondent's 2014-2015 Fiscal Year assessment of \$1,064, as well as \$266 related to the monetary fine for the failure to timely pay the Commission's assessment.
