To Whom It May Concern:

The Commission's records indicate that you have failed to comply with the compliance letter which was sent to you concerning the above docketed and captioned application.

The Compliance Secretarial Letter sets forth specific insurance requirements which were to be met before the Commission would be able to issue your certificate of public convenience evidencing the right to operate as a motor carrier within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The specific insurance forms required, must be sent by the home office of your insurance carrier and they have not filed Form E with the Commission. Therefore, you are not in compliance and we have no recourse but to dismiss your application for non-compliance.

Also since you do not have authority to operate, any operation as a motor carrier in intrastate commerce is a violation of the Public Utility Code and will subject you to the penalties contained therein.

At this time if you wish to operate a motor carrier, you will have to file a new formal application along with the filing fee, to the Public Utility Commission at the above address.
