3 JUDGE DAVID SALAPA:

4 This is the time and the place that the
5 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has set for a
6 hearing in the case captioned Pennsylvania Public
7 Utility Commission, Bureau of Transportation and
8 Safety versus George W. Weaver & Sons, Inc., at Docket
9 Number A-00113647C0501. I'm Administrative Law Judge
10 David Salapa. The Commission has assigned me to
11 preside over this case and to render a decision for
12 the Commission to consider. Appearing this morning
13 is Counsel for the Commission's Bureau of
14 Transportation and Safety, Patricia Wiedt. Good
15 morning, Ms. Wiedt.

1 extensive settlement negotiations, Counsel have

14 that hopefully, we will not have to have a hearing,
15 but nonetheless, I am going to schedule a further
16 hearing in this matter for May 3rd. Counsel should
17 submit the settlement agreement to me on or before ---
18 preferably well before that date. If I receive the
19 settlement agreement in advance of that date, I will
20 then cancel the hearing date, and there will be no
21 hearing. If I do not have the settlement agreement in
22 hand prior to that, I will assume that whatever
23 settlement discussion had taken place have fallen
24 through, and we will proceed with the hearing on May
25 3rd. Should there not be a hearing room available for

1 May 3rd, we will schedule for either May 1st or May
2 2nd. Do Counsel have any questions at this point?

3 ATTORNEY MARSHALL:

4 No, Your Honor.

5 JUDGE SALAPA:

6 Very well, then. I want to thank you for
7 your efforts in resolving this matter, and we are
8 adjourned.

9 ATTORNEY MARSHALL:

10 Thank you.
