Dear Mr. Marzolf:

By Order adopted on March 13, 1997 and entered on March 20, 1997, the Commission granted the transfer application in the above proceeding. Transferee, Jenks, Inc., t/d/b/a Georgia P. Carroll Moving Company, is a minority owned business, and 70% of the stock of the corporation is owned by Cecilia A. Jenkins. Transferee has been certified as a Woman Business Enterprise as well as a Minority Business Enterprise. These certifications are very important to our client and its operations.

On page 1 of the Commission's Order, it is stated that "Earl Jenkins, who is the vice president and sole stockholder of transferee, is the brother of the transferor, Georgia P. Carroll." This statement is incorrect in that, although Earl Jenkins is a stockholder of the transferee, he is not the sole stockholder, and he is not even the majority stockholder. Our client is concerned that this incorrect statement could call into question whether our client is properly certified as a Woman Business Enterprise. We request that the Commission correct this statement to indicate that Earl Jenkins is "a shareholder". The names of our clients' shareholders were set forth in Supplement to Paragraph 12 (b)(6) of the application. This Supplement indicates that Earl Jenkins is not the sole stockholder.

We request that this requested change in the Commission's Order be handled administratively to expedite this matter. We submit that it should not be necessary for the Commission to issue an entirely new Order since this change involves nothing more than a

Dear Mr. O'Boyle:

Under date of March 20, 1997, the Secretary's office transmitted to you the Commission's compliance order adopted March 13, 1997, evidencing approval of the above application which is in effect a transfer of the rights formerly held by Georgia P. Carroll at A-00108243, F.2 and F.3. The letter transmitting the order directs attention to the requirement for the filing of a tariff.

Pa. Code, Title 52, Section 23.13(c) provides that in the case of change of ownership, etc., if feasible to do so, the tariffs of the former operator shall be adopted by the new operator, and no change in rates is permitted to cover the transfer of rights.

In this instance it is not possible to meet the tariff requirements by the adoption of the former tariff for the reason that the present tariff can not be located.

It will be necessary, therefore, to file a new tariff which should be designated Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1. The tariff should name the same rates, rules and regulations as were filed by the former operator and may be issued to become effective on one day's notice under authority of Pa. Code, Title 52, Section 23.42.

Dear Mr. Frazier:

By Order entered on March 20, 1997, the Commission granted the above transfer application of our client, Jenks, Inc., t/d/b/a Georgia P. Carroll Moving Company. The Order states that Applicant must meet the Commission's compliance requirements within 60 days of the date that the Order was entered. On behalf of Applicant, we hereby file this Petition for Extension of Time to Complete the Compliance Requirements.

The due date to meet the compliance requirements is presently May 19, 1997. We hereby request a 30 day extension of time until June 18, 1997. The reason for the extension is that Applicant intends to file a Petition pursuant to Special Order No. 28116 to request permission to publish rates for its household goods operation which are higher than the rates published by the former owner. This is necessary because, by letter dated April 3, 1997, the Commission's Application Review Section notified Applicant that Applicant should publish the same rates, rules and regulations as were filed by the former operator. Although the Commission's staff cannot locate the tariff of the former operator, Applicant believes that the rates in that tariff are, in all probability, considerably lower than the prevailing rates in the application territory and that Applicant could not operate at a reasonable profit by charging the same rates as the former operator.
