Dear Ms. Wilson:

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission adopted an Order at its public meeting held on October 16, 1998, granting the above captioned transfer application. The Order was entered on October 21, 1998. The Order provides that Applicant shall not engage in any transportation pursuant to the authority granted until Applicant submits a tariff and pays the outstanding assessment of \$858. The 60 day compliance period expires on December 21, 1998. On behalf of Applicant, we hereby request a 30 day extension of time for the compliance requirements to be satisfied.

By letter dated October 21, 1998, Applicant was advised that it must file a new tariff naming the same rates, rules and regulations as were filed by the transferor. The letter also informed Applicant that the rates for a part of the authorized service being transferred are provided in tariffs published by Tri-State Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. Applicant has decided not to participate in that agency's publication. It is our understanding that, on or about December 14, 1998, Applicant's tariff agent, Mark Tewes, forwarded to the Commission for filing a Special Permission 28611 Petition. Additional time will be required for the Commission to act upon this Special Permission Petition.
