YOU ARE ADVISED THAT:

A certificate of public convenience will be issued.

UPON THE FILING OF PERMANENT PROOF OF INSURANCE:

- a. Form E, evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance.

You are granted authority to operate as follows.

To transport, as a motor common carrier, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.

You may operate pending the filing of permanent proof of insurance (Temporary proof of insurance is only good for 60 days).

If you have not previously submitted a copy of current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date this letter is entered. You will receive a separate letter on this subject. Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in dismissal of your application.
