On March 15, 2001, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against Carrier Haulers, Inc., respondent, alleging failure to maintain proper evidence of current insurance in violation of the Public Utility Code. The respondent was duly notified that if acceptable evidence of insurance or an answer was not filed, the Bureau would request that the Secretary of the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00113677.

The complaint and notice were served on the respondent by first class mail on or about July 27, 2001; to date, more than twenty (20) days later, neither evidence of insurance nor an answer to the complaint has been filed. Therefore, the allegation in the complaint is deemed to be admitted.

The complaint at A-00113677C0101 is hereby sustained and the right(s) and the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00113677 be and are hereby revoked; and the respondent has no other operating authority. The respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from providing service previously authorized under the certificate of public convenience.

Should respondent wish to again provide Pennsylvania intrastate transportation, the filing of a new application and a \$100.00 fee is required. The application and fee shall be filed with the Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
