Dear Sir:

In reviewing the documentation submitted in the above-captioned transfer application, I find that the following information will be required before I can draft a proposed Order for the Commission's consideration:

1. A list of corporate officers.
2. A list of shareholders (if too numerous, list only the major stockholders).
3. A statement of the applicant's safety program. If the applicant does not have a specific written program, it should make the affirmative statement that it will become familiar with the PUC Safety Code and establish a comprehensive safety program for drivers and equipment.
4. Applicant's financial information - as a minimum, the Commission requires a balance sheet and, if the applicant is currently operating a business, an income statement. If the applicant is a new corporation, with few assets, then the Commission requires the shareholders to submit their personal balance sheets or some other proof (e.g., bank letter of credit) of the financial capacity to continue the operation.

Please submit the requested information to my attention at the above address as soon as possible so that this transfer may be completed.




