

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1991, AS REQUIRED BY THE MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ACT OF 1990 (PUBLIC LAW 101-500), THOSE MOTOR CARRIERS RECEIVING AN "UNSATISFACTORY" SAFETY RATING, ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, ARE PROHIBITED FROM TRANSPORTING PLACARDABLE QUANTITIES OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, OR FOR HIRE TRANSPORTATION OF MORE THAN 15 PASSENGERS, INCLUDING THE DRIVER, IN INTERSTATE COMMERCE.
