- c) Proposed conclusions of law with references to supporting statute or regulation provisions or supporting case law citation.
- d) Proposed ordering paragraphs specifically identifying the relief sought.

4. That an original and nine (9) copies of all Briefs shall be filed in accordance with 52 Pa.Code §5.502(a), one (1) copy shall be served on the presiding Administrative Law Judge, and three (3) copies shall be served on each party of record.


