BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed June 20, 2000. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of July 15, 2000. No protests were filed.

The unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements entered by the applicant and six (6) parties in support.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS:

The applicant currently provides limousine service between points in the counties of Dauphin, Lancaster and York, and from points in said counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and return, pursuant to authority granted September 11, 1998. It operates from an office in Red Lion, York County, using five (5) limousines that will be available to provide the service sought by this application.

Stacia H. Grove provided her latest available financial statement. Grove is financially capable of providing the service sought by this application. As a currently certificated carrier, there is a presumption of fitness.

Six statements from individuals and businesses have been entered in support of the applicant's proposed expansion of service. Considering the now unopposed status of the application, as amended, we determine that the submission of the six statements is sufficient to establish a need for the service.

After complete review of the record, we find:

1. The applicant has the equipment, experience and fitness to provide the proposed service.
2. Approval of the unopposed application, is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED: That the application be and is hereby approved so that the certificate issued September 11, 1998, shall be amended to include the following right.

To transport, as a common carrier, persons, in limousine service, between points in the county of Cumberland, and from points in said county, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation authorized by this order until the following is submitted to the Commission:

1. A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the applicant, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
