Complaint being served on him, alleged to be done so “on or about March 30, 2013 by first class mail. By way of further averment, the Commission’s records indicate a failure to serve Petitioner as evidenced by a returned mail envelope attached hereto, made part hereof and marked as Exhibit “A.”

7. Petitioner cannot state for sure, however he does not believe, that he received the Secretarial Letter of February 3, 2011 or the Complaint dated February 19, 2013.

8. At all relevant times, Petitioner has maintain the statutory required limits of insurance and avers that the appropriate Form E was filed by his insurance carrier.

9. Petitioner maintains that the Commission has had an administrative break down in this matter by not properly serving Petitioner with the said Complaint and failing to act on the this matter for 3 years.

10. Petitioner has investigated the postal issue with his address and it is a result of occupying space in a building located on the corner of Center Street and Market Street in Bethlehem. Although his entrance to the building is on Market Street, the building faces Center Street and there is a question of whether the Market Street address is completely recognized by the postal service. In order to avoid issues in the future, Petitioner will change his address to 458 Center Street, Bethlehem, PA 18018 and file the appropriate address change with the Commission.

11. Under current Commission policy, Petitioner should receive a reinstatement, in accordance with Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Bureau of Transportation and Safety v. Entertainment Transportation Associates, t/a E.T.A. Limousine Service, PUC Docket: C-2009-2049082, because he has addressed all relevant factors:

- Considering the circumstances and the various transactions, the amount of time which elapsed between the date Petitioner's Certificate was cancelled and the filing of this Petition is less than twenty days, indicating the intent of Petitioner not to have the Certificate become dormant and to comply with Commission rules and regulations. This factor is positive for reinstatement.
- The record of Petitioner shows compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations for the approximate 27 years Petitioner has been in business. While Petitioner’s insurance carrier the past may have been slow in filing a Form E, there has never been a lapse in insurance coverage during Petitioner’s certification. This factor is positive for reinstatement.
- Petitioner has not violated the Commission insurance requirements. He did not, however, answer the instant Complaint. The reason for failure to answer was because of his sincere belief that he did not receive the Complaint. The Commission records confirm that the certified mailing of the Complaint was returned and could not determine a date certain, if any, for service on Petitioner.

This factor is positive for reinstatement.

- Petitioner cannot explain the reason for the Commission's inability to have proper process of service on him and will endeavor to establish an address acceptable to the Commission to avoid any like issues in the future. This factor is positive for reinstatement.
- Petitioner is now aware of outstanding fines owed to the Commission, in addition to the \$250.00 fine assessed in this instant matter. He is prepared to pay all outstanding fines.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests Your Honorable Commission to reinstate its Certificate of Public Convenience at Docket Number A-00108039.

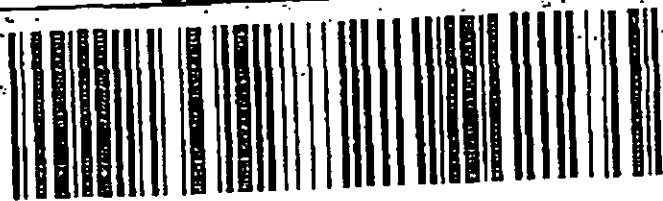

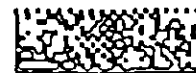
