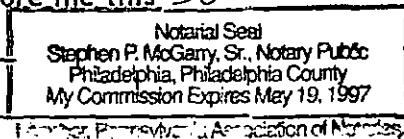

THIS AGREEMENT dated this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1997, BETWEEN  
ANTHONY<sup>J.</sup> PATRONE<sup>JR.</sup>, trading as Anthony PATRONE

with an address of 1943 South Thirteenth Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19148 ("SELLER") and TERRANOVA FUNERAL HOME, INC., a Pennsylvania corporation, with a business address of 1248 South Broad Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19146 ("BUYER"), and the parties intending to be bound by the terms herein, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. Seller agrees to sell to the Buyer the current license in Seller's name as issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission for the operation of a limousine business which is presently conducted by Seller. This license is the sole asset being purchased by the Buyer.

2. The purchase price for the license shall be \$1,500.00 which shall be paid in cash, cashier's check or certified check within ten (10) days following approval of Buyer's application for the transfer of the license from Seller to Buyer by the office of the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission.


3. Seller warrants and represents that there are no unpaid business debts or taxes arising out of the conduct of the former limousine business. In the event that any third party or governmental authority asserts a claim to unpaid business debts or taxes arising out of Seller's conduct of the business, Seller agrees to indemnify and hold Buyer harmless from any such claims.

4. For a period of two (2) years from the date of this Agreement, Seller agrees that he shall not reestablish or become directly or indirectly involved in the operation of any limousine business within the City of Philadelphia.

5. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth

of Pennsylvania and the parties agree that any disputes arising hereunder shall be determined only by a court of competent jurisdiction in the venue of Philadelphia County.

6. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and shall only be modified in writing and executed by both parties.

REPORT AND ORDER  
APPROVING PASSENGER SERVICE

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter being before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission upon application of ANTHONY PATRONE, Jr., dated November 4, 1953, to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier, and having been duly heard and submitted by the parties, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, and it appearing that the rights granted herein are in effect a transfer of the rights which have been held by ANTONIO PATRONE (deceased), under certificate of public convenience issued at A. 42128 on April 17, 1950, which certificate will be subsequently cancelled as of the date of this order, upon compliance with the tariff and insurance requirements of the Commission by ANTHONY PATRONE, Jr., the Commission finds and determines that approval of the application, limited to the following right:

To transport, as a common carrier, funeral accessories between points in the City and County of Philadelphia and within an airline distance of thirty (30) miles of City Hall in said city;

To transport, as a common carrier, persons attending funerals and flowers for funerals between points in the City and County of Philadelphia, and within an airline distance of thirty (30) miles of City Hall in said city;

To transport, as a common carrier, persons attending weddings and christening parties to or from homes of wedding or christening services and churches or places at which marriage ceremonies or christening services are performed in the City and County of Philadelphia;

and subject to the following conditions, is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation or convenience of the public:

FIRST: That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the property and/or rights to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or proscribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.

SECOND: That the accounts of the transferee will reflect the same book values as the records of the transferor at the effective date of the transfer, any previously recorded appreciation having been deleted therefrom; provided, that the applicant shall not record in his utility accounts any amount representing the rights herein granted, in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.

THIRD: That the certificate holder shall comply with all the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Bus and Taxicab Regulations effective April 15, 1946, or as may hereafter be revised, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the Certificate.

NOW, to wit, January 25, 1954, IT IS ORDERED: That upon compliance with all requirements of the Public Utility Law relative to tariffs and insurance, and with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Commission thereunder, a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing the Commission's approval of the right to operate, as above determined.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before thirty (30) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

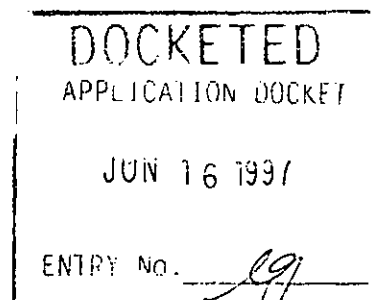

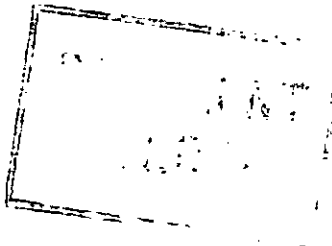

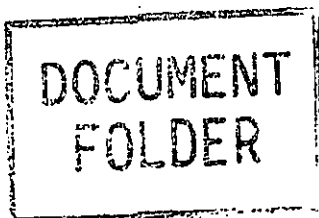
