The majority of the complaints referenced above were price related, in that the customers were on fixed rate plans, and market prices declined after the start of their contract. The other main category of complaints involved business owners or managers who questioned the decision by other managers or employees to enroll with Atlantic. Every single one of the complaints was resolved amicably without a hearing, and none of the complaints involved any finding of wrongdoing by Atlantic.

**d. OVERSIGHT OF MARKETING:** Explain all methods Applicant will use to ensure all marketing is performed in an ethical manner, for both employees and subcontractors.

Atlantic will apply various business, overview and monitoring practices to ensure that all marketing efforts are conducted and implemented on a continuous basis in conformance with Atlantic's best practices and training standards. The elements of the compliance program are tailored to the concerns and individual components of each distinct marketing modality, designed to incentivize representatives to act responsibly and will be implemented in a workable and effective manner.

Agents will be trained on all requirements of 52 Pa. Code 62.77 and 111.5 – 111.12 before commencing marketing. The following standards will be specifically emphasized and incorporated into sales training: the need to produce and make visible the Atlantic photo-ID; the requirement provide a copy of the Atlantic Terms and Conditions and Disclosure Statement, the requirement to inform the customer that the agent represents Atlantic, an independent energy marketer; inform the customer that the customer's utility will continue to deliver their energy and will respond to any leaks or emergencies; the obligation to provide the customer with written information regarding Atlantic's products and services immediately upon request which shall include Atlantic's name and telephone number for inquires, verification and complaints; and where it is apparent that the customer's English language skills are insufficient to allow the customer to understand and respond to the information conveyed by the representative or where the customer or another third party informs the representative of this circumstance, the representative shall either find a representative in the area who is fluent in the customer's language to continue the marketing activity in his/her stead or terminate the in-person contact with the customer.

All materials and agreements provided to the customer will comply with and be provided to the customer in conformance with the applicable Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code 54.5 A new salesperson will be accompanied by a Supervisor during their initial marketing visit to ensure that the salesperson conducts the solicitation in accordance with Atlantic's standards. The salesperson will be informed of any deficiencies and the corrective action(s) to be taken. All marketing teams will be sent out under the supervision of a Team Supervisor, who will be available to respond to questions and inquiries.

All Door to Door sales will be confirmed by the use of either a third party verification process or by an automated voice verification system owned and operated by Atlantic. All recordings and TPV will follow the requirements codified the Commission's regulations and will be designed to confirm the customer's intent to either initiate and enroll supply service with Atlantic or continue or modify the service they receive from Atlantic. Atlantic will design and review the script used for such verifications.

In addition, Atlantic will, on a random and regular basis, conduct in-field reviews of door to door solicitations to ensure that the representatives are following the standards codified in the Program. In the event problems are discerned, the representative will be informed of any deficiency and advised that he/she may be terminated if the deficiency is not immediately corrected. Atlantic will work with the representative to address any identified deficiency. Atlantic will reserve the right to immediately terminate the representative if it determines that the representative's behavior or attitude is incompatible with Atlantic's quality control standards.

Atlantic will also, on a random and regular basis, review a meaningful sample of verifications to ensure that the representatives are following the standards codified in the Program. In the event problems are discerned, the representative will be informed of any deficiency and advised that he/she may be terminated if the deficiency is not immediately corrected. Atlantic will work with the representative to address any identified deficiency. Atlantic will reserve the right to immediately terminate the representative if it determines that the representative's behavior or attitude is incompatible with Atlantic's quality control standards.

Atlantic will design and review the marketing script and verifications to be used for all sales solicitations. Atlantic will ensure that background checks are conducted on all prospective salespersons to ensure they are suitable for employment on Atlantic's marketing campaigns.
