DUQUESNE LIGHT CO. COPY
LICENSE AGREEMENT

The undersigned Grantor, **REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF ALLEGHENY COUNTY**, a redevelopment authority, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto Duquesne Light Company, its successors and assigns, for providing, transmitting and/or distributing electric and/or communications services for any and all purposes, the license to erect, install, use, own, operate, maintain, repair, renew and finally remove an electric line, consisting of **two (2) poles (item 2-#370001) and (item 3-#369782)**, together with crossarms, cables, wires, **three (3) anchors**, guys and other fixtures and apparatus thereto belonging, upon, over, under, along, across and through Grantors land, fronting on **Helen Street**, situate in **Swissvale Borough, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (having Tax I.D. 178-R-225-1)** and shown on Duquesne Light Company Drawing No. **585141 rev.1**, a copy of which has been given to Grantor and are attached hereto; Duquesne Light Company shall also have the following rights: to trim or remove any trees or shrubbery which, at any time or times, may interfere or threaten to interfere with the erection, installation, use, operation, maintenance, repair, renewal or removal of the electric line; to enter upon the land at any time for such purposes; to permit others to attach crossarms, cables, wires and related apparatus, and to use the poles and apparatus erected hereunder; and to sell, assign, lease or otherwise transfer any or all of the rights hereunder.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this agreement, Duquesne Light Company agrees that the electric and/or communications facilities ("Facilities") installed hereunder shall be relocated upon the request of the Grantor, if Grantor determines (in its sole discretion) that the location of the licensed area interferes with Grantor's proposed or actual plans for future development; provided, however, that Grantor provides an alternate location suitable for the Facilities, in Duquesne Light Company's reasonable discretion, and Grantor pays Duquesne Light Company's costs for such relocation.

Duquesne shall file a copy of this Agreement with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission as required by Title 66, Section 507 of the Public Utility Code and this Agreement shall become effective in accordance therewith.

Intending to be legally bound the parties have executed this agreement this 15 day of APRIL, 2016.

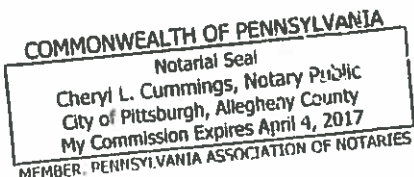
