

In lieu of the applicable rates provided for in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 for the above carrier the following rates shall apply for all shipments originating in Allegheny, ▲Beaver, ▲Butler, ▲Washington and ▲Westmoreland and transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

NOTE 1 - When a Holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 3 shall be applicable.

NOTE 2 - Minimum total transportation charges: Sundays and Holidays: 8 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 3.

NOTE 3 - Minimum total transportation charges: ▲Monday-Saturday: 4 hours at rates named in Columns 1, 2 and 4.

NOTE 4 - Where service commence at the request of the shipper after 5:30 PM, rates shall be on a time and one-half basis as shown in Column 2 of Table A.

NOTE 5 - When distance from original point of origin to final destination is:

- (a) 20 miles or less - flat charge shall be one hour at the applicable rates.
- (b) Over 20 miles but less than 30 - flat charge shall be one and one-half hours at the applicable rates.
- (c) 30 miles and over (to 40 miles inclusive) - flat charge shall be two hours at the applicable rates.

▲NOTE 6 - When pianos and safes are part of a move, the following flat charges will apply in addition to the hourly rates:
