Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PUC" or "Commission") Secretarial Letter dated June 10, 2015 ("June Letter"), in Docket No. A-2010-2196823, and 52 Pa. Code § 54.40(d), The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania ("Penn") hereby respectfully request to renew Penn's reduced bond level, effective on or before June 15, 2016.

In order to hold an electric generation supplier ("EGS") license in the Commonwealth, the applicant must furnish a bond or other security that demonstrates financial responsibility. 66 Pa.C.S. § 2809(c). After its first year in operation, a licensed EGS must submit its security level to the Commission for review and may seek approval for an alternative level of bonding commensurate with its nature and scope of operation. 52 Pa. Code. § 54.40(d). According to the Commission's Order entered July 24, 2014 ("July 24 Order") at Docket No. M-2013-2393141, an EGS may file a petition seeking a reduction in its level of security from 10% to 5% of its most recent 12 months' of revenue or \$250,000, whichever is higher. See July 24 Order, pp.10-11.

Penn has operated as a licensed EGS in the Commonwealth for several years. In the June Letter, the Commission granted Penn's initial Bond Reduction Petition. Pursuant to the June Letter, and in accordance with the Commission's regulation and guidance, Penn submits this Petition for Bond Reduction Renewal ("Renewal Petition"). See July 24 Order; 52 Pa. Code. § 54.40(d). In support of its Renewal Petition, Penn has enclosed the following documents for filing with the Commission:

(1) Attachment A, which sets forth Penn's gross revenues for the sale of electricity to retail customers in Pennsylvania for the most recent 12 months;

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The June Letter reduced Penn's bonding level from 10% to 5% of its most recent 12-months of revenues. To be clear, this Renewal Petition only seeks to renew Penn's reduced bonding level, not its form of security.

(2) Attachment B, which includes a Certificate of Good Standing from the Department of Revenue in support of Penn's request for a bond level reduction.

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$350 made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to cover the requisite filing fee for Penn's Renewal Petition.

Penn respectfully requests that the Commission grant confidential treatment of the documents found at Attachments A-B accompanying this Renewal Petition. As a privately held entity, the enclosed information is not available to the public and is believed by Penn to be of a proprietary or confidential nature and is so designated by being stamped "Confidential." Penn respectfully requests that the Commission treat these documents as confidential, place them under seal, and prevent public disclosure in accordance with the Commission's procedures.
