To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter/Commission Order dated November 20, 1997, you were informed that, before you would be issued a certificate of public convenience, permanent proof of insurance had be filed with this Commission. Acceptable proof is a Form E (evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance) and a Form H (evidence of cargo liability insurance). You were given sixty days to comply with this requirement. To date, **one or more of the proper filings have not been made.**

Unless this Commission receives acceptable evidence of permanent insurance within twenty days from the date of this letter, **your application will be dismissed for non-compliance.** If your application is dismissed, you will not be permitted to operate in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. You must file a new application, along with the required application fee, to become a certificated PUC carrier.
