To Whom It May Concern:

The Bureau of Transportation & Safety - Insurance/Filing Unit has notified our office that your have failed to comply with our letter which was sent to you concerning the above docketed and captioned Application.

The Compliance Secretarial Letter set forth specific insurance requirements which were to be met before the Commission would issue a certificate of public convenience evidencing the right to operate as a motor carrier within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The specific insurance forms required, which were to e forwarded to the Commission by the home office of your insurance carrier, have not been received. Therefore, we have no recourse but to dismiss your application for non-compliance.

Please be advised that you do not have authority to operate, and any operation as a motor carrier in intrastate commerce will be a violation of the Public Utility Code and will subject you to the penalties contained therein.

If you desire to operate as a motor carrier, you will have to file a new Application together with the appropriate filing fee.
