

**CONSENT MOTION TO CONTINUE PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Respondent Duquesne Light Company, by and through its attorneys, Tucker Arensberg, P.C., files this Consent Motion to Continue Prehearing Conference, stating as follows:

1. On April 12, 2016, the Commission issued a Second Interim Order Concerning Prehearing Conference ("Second Interim Order") that scheduled a prehearing conference for Tuesday, May 17, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.

2. The Second Interim Order requires that "an authorized representative of each Party and their respective attorneys [ ] appear *in person* before the undersigned presiding Administrative Law Judge for the conference" (emphasis in original).

3. Duquesne Light's authorized representative (and one of its counsel, Anthony Kanagy, Esq.) has a scheduling conflict on May 17, 2016, that prevents them from attending the prehearing conference in person. The scheduling conflict is a deposition in another matter pending before the Commission, captioned at Whemco-Steel Castings, Inc. v. Duquesne Light Co., Docket No. C-2014-2459527 (Watson, ALJ).

4. Another reason to postpone the prehearing conference is that Complainant has filed a Petition for Interlocutory Review, which is pending. Under 52 Pa. Code § 5.303, the Commission has thirty days in which to respond to the Petition.

5. For these reasons, Duquesne Light respectfully requests a continuance of the prehearing conference.

6. Complainant's attorney has been consulted about and consented to the continuance requested in this Motion.


7. All counsel and party representatives have availability during the first two weeks of June 2016 and respectfully request that the prehearing conference be rescheduled to a date and time during that window that is convenient for the presiding Administrative Law Judge.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Duquesne Light Company, with Complainant's consent, respectfully requests that the prehearing conference currently scheduled for May 17, 2016, be rescheduled as requested in this Motion.
