



AND NOW comes Respondent, Duquesne Light Company, by and through its attorneys, Tucker Arensberg, P.C., and files this Uncontested Motion for Continuance of Hearing in accordance with Commission regulation 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b):


1. The above-captioned Formal Complaint was filed on or about February 22, 2016, and was scheduled for an Initial Telephonic Hearing for Monday, May 9, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.
2. On May 2, 2016, Complainant requested that the hearing date be continued for medical reasons. Duquesne Light did not oppose Complainant's request for a continuance. By First Interim Order dated May 3, 2016, Administrative Law Judge Dunderdale granted Complainant's request for a continuance.
3. The Commission issued a Call-In Telephone Cancellation/Reschedule Hearing Notice on May 4, 2016, which rescheduled the hearing in this matter to July 19, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.

4. Undersigned counsel has previously scheduled plans that take him out of the state on the date and time of the rescheduled hearing.¹ Therefore, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that a new hearing date be set.
5. Undersigned counsel is available for a rescheduled hearing during the week of July 25, 2016, which is the week after the currently scheduled hearing date.
6. Undersigned counsel spoke with Ms. Hawn at approximately 10:30 a.m. on May 6, 2016, and she has given her consent to the requested continuance.
