

NOTE 1 - **MINIMUM TRANSPORTATION CHARGES:** Sundays and Holidays: 8 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Saturdays (any hour) or Weekdays: 5:01PM to 6:00AM: 4 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 2 - Rates in Column 4 apply only from 5:01 PM to 12:00 Midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown for the following day.

NOTE AA - When distance from original point of origin to final destination is 10 miles or less, the flat charge shall be for one-half hour at the rates applicable.
 When distance from original point of origin to final destination is over 10 miles but less than 20 miles, the flat charge shall be for one hour at the rates applicable.
 When distance from original point of origin to final destination is 20 miles and less than 30 miles, the flat charge shall be for one and one-half hours at the rate applicable.
 When distance from original point of origin to final destination is 30 miles and over (to 40 miles inclusive), the flat charge shall be for two hours at the rates applicable.

NOTE BB - When the point of origin is more than 40 miles from carrier's place of business and the point of delivery is more than 25 miles from carrier's place of business, a one hour travel charge will be assessed for each 25 mile increment or portion thereof beyond 40 miles to the point of origin.

NOTE CC - A flat charge based on 2 hours at the applicable transportation rates in Columns 2, 3 or 4 will be assessed by carrier when travel from carrier's place of business to original point of origin is more than 25 miles. Charges applicable under Note BB and Note CC.
