PREHEARING ORDER

On January 11, 1999, I was assigned to be the presiding officer in over this matter. The purpose of this order is to bring to the attention of the parties certain procedural rules which apply to the participants in this proceeding. This case is scheduled to be heard in an available hearing room on the 13th floor of the Philadelphia State Office Building on Wednesday, March 10, 1999 at 10:00 a.m.

The Applicant has asked the Commission for an exemption from the provisions in 52 Pa. Code §33.122(f) for the construction of new high level platforms at the New Eastwick Station in Philadelphia.

The parties are reminded of the availability of this Commission's rules on discovery, found in Subchapter D, Chapter 5 of 52 Pa. Code, for learning the facts underlying each party's position on the pending application.

Questions and Procedures were forwarded with the hearing notice. All prepared written testimony should be served on the presiding officer and the other parties on or before February 18, 1999.

Please note that Benjamin C. Dunlap, Jr., Esquire entered his appearance on behalf of the Consolidated Rail Corporation on January 22, 1999.

By correspondence, dated February 1, 1999, Gina D'Alfonso, Esquire advised me that the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation will not be participating in the hearing. Nevertheless, Ms. D'Alfonso should be copied on all documentation in this matter.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b), requests for postponement or continuance of hearings must be submitted in writing no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing. Requests for postponement or continuance of initial hearings are to be sent to the Chief Administrative Law Judge Robert A. Christianson with copies to the presiding officer and parties of record.

Finally, all parties are reminded that each party wishing to offer an exhibit is required to provide two copies to the court reporter, one copy to the presiding officer and one copy to each of party of record. 52 Pa. Code §5.409.
