PENNSYLVANIA REGULATION OF INTRASTATE PASSENGER CARRIERS

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issues Certificates of Public Convenience to carriers for the transportation of passengers for compensation when operating between points in Pennsylvania. Intrastate service involves the picking-up and dropping-off of passengers where both the origin and destination are in Pennsylvania.

An application must be filed and a certificate must be issued before service may be provided solely within the borders of the Commonwealth.

Carriers of passengers; taxi; limousine; airport transfer; paratransit (van service); group and party service when operating vehicles seating 15 passengers or less, including the driver; and scheduled route bus service, file for authority using PA PUC Form 178. The same form may be used for each of these classes of regulated service. A filing fee of \$350.00 is required for each class of service. Publication of the application is made in the Pennsylvania Bulletin to give notice to the public.

Any currently Pennsylvania certificated carrier holding the same type of authority in the area of application may file a "protest" to the granting of the application. "Protests" must be filed with the Commission and the applicant within 15 days of the publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. Carriers have the opportunity to resolve protests through negotiations with the objectors. If an agreement between the parties cannot be reached, the application may be assigned for mediation or for hearing before a PA PUC Administrative Law Judge.

Charter bus, tour and special excursion operators, exclusively operating vehicles seating 16 or more, including the driver, file for authority using Form PUC-GP. A \$100.00 filing fee is required. Upon acceptance and review of the application, the Commission will issue a Secretarial letter granting the right to provide group and party service between points in Pennsylvania. Carriers of passengers operating vehicles, in group and party service, that seat more than 15 passengers, including the driver, must undergo a safety fitness review conducted by a Commission Safety Officer.

INSURANCE

As a PUC carrier, evidence of insurance must be maintained with the Commission to meet our minimum requirements (see page 4). The Commission requires all carriers to provide evidence of insurance by the filing of a Form E as proof of bodily injury and property damage insurance. A carrier's failure to maintain evidence of insurance can result in cancellation of its operating authority.

TARIFFS & RATES

Carriers of passengers, except group and party carriers using vehicles seating 16 or more, including the driver, must file a tariff containing their rates for service within Pennsylvania. Any change in rates must be approved by the Commission.

ASSESSMENTS

All carriers are subject to an annual assessment based upon their reported gross operating revenue from Pennsylvania transportation. Currently the assessment bill is less than 1% of reported revenue. Carriers subject to the annual assessment are mailed a form each year to complete and return to the Commission.

SAFETY

All carriers must comply with the Commission's safety regulations contained in 52 Pa. Code Chapter 37, which adopts the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations at 49 CFR.

MARKING OF VEHICLES

As a PUC certificated carrier, you are required to mark your vehicles with the name of the carrier and the PUC-A#. The power unit must be marked in letters no less than 2 inches high by 1/2 inch in width. Vehicles operated in limousine service are exempt from this requirement.

OTHER GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

All carriers have an obligation to inform the Commission in writing of any change of address. This is especially important to the carrier as

information concerning insurance and other matters is routinely mailed to the carrier.

FINES AND PENALTIES

The Commission is very serious about its responsibility to the citizens of the Commonwealth that carriers operating under authority granted by the Commission are properly insured and are in compliance with our safety regulations. Carriers under our jurisdiction must be aware that fines and other penalties may be imposed when the Commission determines that violations of our regulations have occurred. Fines range from \$50.00 to \$1,000.00 depending on the severity of the violation.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION, DRIVER LICENSING, SPECIAL PERMITS

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has jurisdiction over the issuance of vehicle registration plates, commercial driver licenses, and hazardous materials transportation and oversize/overweight permits. PennDot can be reached at 1-800-932-4600.

16 to 28 passengers:

\$1,000,000 to cover liability for bodily injury, death or property damage incurred in an accident.

29 passengers or more:

\$5,000,000 to cover liability for bodily injury, death or property damage incurred in an accident.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN PREPARING AND FILING THE APPLICATION.

You must be at least 18 years of age to file an application.

1. This application is required to operate as a commercial carrier of persons, when providing transportation between points in Pennsylvania. **You must submit a separate application for each class of passenger authority sought.**
2. The signed original and one copy of the application must be filed with the Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, PO Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
3. A non-refundable filing fee of **\$350.00** is required at the time of filing. Applications without the required fee will be returned. The filing fee must be paid **by certified check or money order made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.** In the alternative, a check drawn on an attorney's account is acceptable. Please staple the filing fee to the application.
4. It is not required that an applicant be represented by an attorney to file an application. However, partnerships and corporations must be represented by an attorney at hearing.
5. Corporations and fictitious trade names must be registered with the Pennsylvania Department of State. Pennsylvania corporations are issued a Certificate of Incorporation. Company's incorporated in other states must register with Pennsylvania as a foreign business corporation. A certificate of authority to do business in Pennsylvania will be issued to non-Pennsylvania corporations. Call the Pennsylvania Department of State at 717-787-1057 for the necessary forms and additional information.

Prior to providing service in Pennsylvania, you must submit evidence of insurance to the Public Utility Commission. **Your permanent evidence of insurance will be a Form E for bodily injury and property damage insurance.** (See reverse of this page for minimum insurance limits). This form is mailed to the Commission directly from the home office of your insurance carrier and must have the exact name and address which you have provided at lines 1, 3 or 4 of the application.

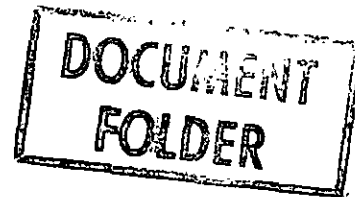

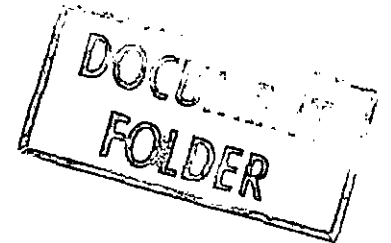

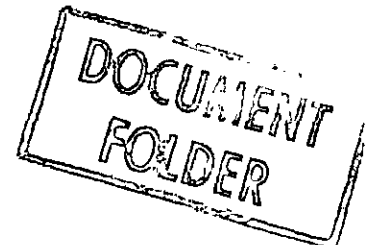
