Dear Sir:

This is in response to the complaint filed against me for failing to maintain evidence of insurance on file with the PA public utility commission.

Upon receipt of first notice of suspension, it was verified with my insurance agent (Beacon Insurance Agency) that my insurance company (Progressive/United Financial Casualty Company) had made the proper filings. I also received notification by mail that the filings had been made.

However, upon receiving the formal complaint, further investigation revealed that there had been 2 mistakes in the filing – company name was listed simply as L P Martin instead of L P Martin Transport, and the date was incorrect.

Our records/receipts show that there was never a lapse in insurance coverage. The problem was typo errors in the insurance company filings.

Phone conversation with PUC office verified that filings have been corrected.

I am asking that you please waive the \$500 penalty.
