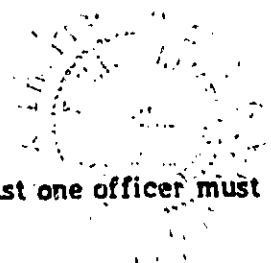

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with the requirements of the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1972, Act No. 271, approved November 15, 1972, the undersigned, all of whom are of full age and sui juris and all of whom are residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and citizens of the United States, desiring to form a nonprofit corporation, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I. The name of the corporation is BROCKWAY AREA AMBULANCE SERVICE, INC.

ARTICLE II. The location and post office address of its initial registered office in this Commonwealth is 957 Fifth Avenue, Brockway, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania.

ARTICLE III. The purposes of the corporation are:

(a) To provide a responsive and constant emergency medical facility, through the maintenance of a motorized ambulance and other emergency equipment, served by a trained, volunteer crew proficient in life support procedure and first aid.

(b) To purchase or otherwise acquire for the corporation any property, right or privilege, which the corporation is authorized by law to purchase, or otherwise acquire at such prices and consideration, and upon such terms, and conditions as the Court may consider advisable.

(c) To sell, or otherwise dispose of, transfer or convey, any property of the corporation, at such prices and consideration and upon such terms and conditions, as the Board may consider advisable, except as otherwise provided by law or the Articles of Incorporation.

(d) To borrow money and to make and issue notes, bonds and other negotiable and transfer instruments, mortgages, deeds of trust, and trust agreements, and do every act or thing necessary to effectuate the same.

(e) To appoint and remove, or suspend, such employees, agents or factors as they may be necessary; to determine their duties; to fix and from time to time, to change their salaries or remuneration, and to require security as when they think fit.

(f) To authorize any officer or officers, manager, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name and on behalf of the corporation and such authority may be general or confined to specific incidents.

ARTICLE IV. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes as defined and limited by Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE V. No members of the corporation shall receive any pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, from its activities, except that the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to enforce legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future

United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by the corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE VI. The corporation shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VII. The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE X. If the corporation is to be dissolved, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation conclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which

the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and granted exclusively for such purposes.

At item 10 of the application your description of the service proposed must be modified to comply with Commission phraseology. For example, a description using the information you have provided might read:

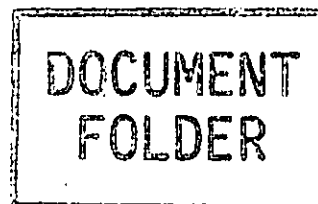

You should tailor a description to meet your proposed service using the above phraseology as a guide. I urge you to call me direct at 717-783-5946, if you have any questions as to how this should be done.

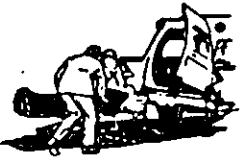

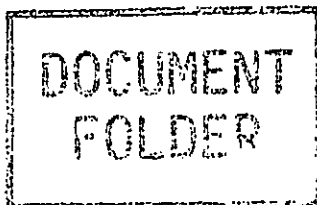
Thank you very much for your assistance in correctly phrasing the reply to item ten. I called your office and they assured me your phraseology would be very acceptable.
