



Dear Sir:

I am returning your application and cashier's check # 22501256 in the amount of \$350.00, as the application requires clarification.

At item ten of the application, you are required to describe the proposed service. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission only has jurisdiction over transportation service within its borders, consequently your reference to Newark and JFK airports is beyond our jurisdiction and should be deleted from the description. As a matter of information, you may want to contact the Federal Highway Administration at 202-358-7000 to check on Federal requirements for interstate transportation.

Typically, an airport transfer carrier will describe a base of operation on one hand and list the Pennsylvania airports to be served on the other hand. For example, a description may read as follows:

To transport, as a common carrier, persons in airport transfer service, from points in the borough of New Hope, Bucks County, and points within an airline distance of 20 statute miles of the said borough, to the Philadelphia International Airport and the Allentown Bethlehem Easton Airport, in the counties of Lehigh and Northampton.

Use the above sample as a guide in the language to be used in describing your service. If you have any questions concerning this requirement, I urge you to telephone me direct at 717-783-5946. Resubmit the application and filing fee to my attention when the corrections have been made.
