"RULES AND REGULATIONS"

Advance Reservations

Advance reservations are not required prior to service since the company would only fulfill rides requested by the Transportation Network Provider. e.g: LogistiCare. Trip assignments through Logisticare can be either be accepted or rejected by the provider.

Rates

Rates are determined by advance trip mileage calculations via Mapquest or another directional service and a "fixed" (per mile) rate is paid to the provider for the first five miles and then every mile thereafter in increments. Rates begin when the vehicle leaves the passenger's residence and arrives at said destination. The same is true for the return ride.

All rates will be determined by the transportation network manager, which we will utilize (LogistiCare), who provides standard rates for all their registered LogistiCare transportation providers. Mileage rates from LogistiCare to network providers are definite.

Deposits and Cancellations

No deposits are required for transportation of passengers and all cancellations and their costs shall not be charged to the client or the Contractor (Logisticare).

Additional Expenses

All expenses incurred in the act of picking up and dropping off passengers shall be the sole responsibility of Lee-Lee Non-Emergency Medical Transportation and not be charged or demanded from the network transportation management company or the client. This would include tolls, gas, parking, parking tickets or any out of pocket expenses that may become payable by the carrier.
