PERMANENT PROOF OF INSURANCE:**

- a. Form E, as evidence of bodily injury and property damage
liability insurance, and
- b. Form H, as evidence of cargo liability insurance; or cargo
waiver.

You are granted authority to operate as follows:

To transport, as a motor common carrier, property, excluding household goods in use,
between points in Pennsylvania.

**FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE WITHIN SIXTY
(60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE
APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.**

**You may want to operate prior to filing permanent proof of insurance. Temporary
proof of insurance consists of two elements(Temporary proof of insurance is only
good for 60 days from the date of this letter). You need to file:**

For bodily injury and property damage (BIPD) only (submit one)

- a. A copy of the insurance identification card for vehicles registered in Pennsylvania; **or**
- b. A copy of the declaration page of the insurance policy; **or**
- c. A copy of a valid binder of insurance; **or**
- d. A copy of valid application for insurance to the Pennsylvania Automobile Insurance Plan.


- and -

For cargo insurance (submit one)

- a. A copy of the declaration page of the insurance policy; **or**
- b. A copy of a valid binder of insurance; **or**
- c. A copy of a cargo waiver

If you have not previously submitted a copy of a current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered. **Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in dismissal of your application.**
