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Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 54.40(d), the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PUC" or "Commission") Order at Docket No. M-2013-2393141 (entered July 24, 2014) ("July 24 Order"), and letter providing guidance on Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") Licensee Financial Security dated April 8, 2016 ("Guidance Letter"), Jack Rich, Incorporated, d/b/a Anthracite Power and Light Company ("Jack Rich"), hereby respectfully requests to reduce its bond level.¹

In order to hold an EGS license in the Commonwealth, the applicant must furnish a bond or other security that demonstrates financial responsibility. 66 Pa.C.S. § 2809(c). After its first year in operation, a licensed EGS must submit its security level to the Commission for review and may seek approval for an alternative level of bonding commensurate with its nature and scope of operation. 52 Pa. Code. § 54.40(d). According to the Commission's July 24 Order, as clarified by the Guidance Letter, an EGS may file a petition seeking a reduction in its level of security from 10% to 5% of its most recent 12 months' of revenue or \$250,000, whichever is higher. See July 24 Order, pp.10-11; Guidance Letter, p. 2.

Jack Rich has operated as a licensed EGS in the Commonwealth for several years. In accordance with the Commission's regulation and guidance, Jack Rich submits this Petition for Bond Reduction ("Petition"). See 52 Pa. Code. § 54.40(d); July 24 Order, pp. 10-11; Guidance Letter, p. 2. In support of its Petition, Jack Rich has enclosed the following documents for filing with the Commission:

Attachment A, which sets forth Jack Rich's gross revenues for the sale of (1)electricity to retail customers in Pennsylvania for the most recent 12 months; and

(2) Attachment B, which includes a Certificate of Good Standing from the Department of Revenue in support of Jack Rich's request for a bond level reduction.

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$350 made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to cover the requisite filing fee for Jack Rich's Petition.

Jack Rich respectfully requests that the Commission grant confidential treatment of the documents found at Attachments A and B accompanying this Petition. As a privately held entity, the enclosed information is not available to the public and is believed by Jack Rich to be of a proprietary or confidential nature and is so designated by being stamped "Confidential." Jack Rich respectfully requests that the Commission treat these documents as confidential, place them under seal, and prevent public disclosure in accordance with the Commission's procedures.
